

Postdoctoral Position: Molecular Immunology

A two-year postdoctoral position funded by the European Union Marie Curie FP7-IAPP program is available immediately in the laboratory of Dr. Christos Tsatsanis at the Department of Laboratory Medicine, School of Medicine, University of Crete, Heraklion, Greece.

A highly motivated individual is sought to investigate the role of micro RNAs and signaling molecules in innate immune responses using in vivo and cell culture models (Immunity 2009, 31(2): 220-231).

Candidates must have a PhD, experience on in vivo models of inflammatory diseases, cell culture and basic molecular biology methods. Eligible candidates must not have resided or carried out their main activity in Greece for more than 12 months in the last 3 years.
