The section of Hematology/Oncology in the Department of Pediatrics at the Arizona Health Sciences Center is seeking two Board Certified or Board Eligible Pediatric Hematologist/Oncologists.

For the first position the applicant should have fellowship training and special interest in stem cell transplantation and for the second position the candidate should have a special interest in solid tumors. The incumbents will be appointed at the Assistant/Associate Professor level (open rank). Collaboration with the other five members of the section, members of the Department, faculty in the Steele Children's Research Center and the NCI-designated Arizona Cancer Center will be encouraged.

Our program will continue to grow with the building of Diamond Children's Hospital, scheduled to be completed in early 2010. An 18 bed/room pediatric Hematology-Oncology unit will be located on the 6th floor adjacent to the pediatric ICU. This will be unique in the state of Arizona because it will be the only Children's Hospital connected to an academic research facility; the Steele Children's Research Center. The center will provide an integrated system of clinical care, cutting-edge research, and training of the next generation of pediatricians.
